This year the annual SGGEE convention was held at the Travelodge Hotel & Convention Centre on August 10, 11 and 12 in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada. These dates were chosen to correspond with the Regina Folk Festival being held at Victoria Park.

The theme of the conference was "SGGEE: The Key to Your Family Tree". Outgoing president Bill Tucholke provided the Friday welcoming speech while John Marsch served as MC throughout the conference. By popular demand, Felix Kuehn was selected as the banquet speaker and again provided a humorous and entertaining presentation while those in attendance dined on an excellent buffet style meal.

The exit survey comments from last year in Winnipeg were extremely helpful in selecting our workshop topics, recruiting speakers and continuing to provide a "research room".
