

LIST OF SEPARATED GERMAN REFUGEE FAMILIES IN RUSSIA DURING WORLD WAR ONE AS REPORTED IN THE SARATOV “VOLKSZEITUNG”

Countless German families from Poland, the Baltics, and the Western and Southwestern Provinces became separated during their forced flight to inner Russia in 1915. The usual causes of this calamity were the removal of sick family members from trains and mishaps at railroad stations, as when a family member failed to return to the train from a shopping trip into town. There was no way of knowing when trains would move on, and no way of asking for delay until a family member returned.

Between March 19, 1915 and June 5, 1916 (when the paper was shut down), the Volkszeitung carried notices on its last page (page 4) sent in by people looking for lost family members. Usually only one notice appeared, but sometimes a notice appeared in 2 or 3 successive issues (2 issues per week). In one heart-rending case, a notice appeared again after 6 months. We have no way of knowing, of course, what percentage of the total number of missing persons is accounted for in these notices. Saratov was a major city to or through which refugees were sent, but not the only one. The approximately 300 families in this list probably represent only a small fraction of the families torn apart by this expulsion. Some families used other means of locating relatives, and many were successful at finding them, thanks to the various agencies (and the postal service) that worked to aid the refugees. But one cannot help but wonder how many of these families were never again united.

Each entry signifies a story which we can only imagine. A few stand out, such as the large number of men from the Garwolin area of Lublin who were all seeking their families already in late March, 1915. Army commanders may have expelled these men first, as they sometimes did, leaving the families to be dealt with a few days later. Or one may be struck by the cruel irony of the eight soldiers on the Caucasian warfront seeking information about their families expelled by the government for which they were fighting. On a smaller scale, we have the Arndt parents looking for their one- and three-year-old children. The contact addresses show the important role played by many pastors and teachers as well as the variety of living conditions, ranging from probably prosperous rural chutors to brick and sausage factories in Saratov. Others had been sent beyond the Volga, to Astrakhan and Siberia.

It is interesting that the paper carried a report in its “Von den Kolonien” section on October 4, 1915 from a Chr. Schneider in Warenburg in which the reporter notes the presence of many Germans from Poland living in the Volga colonies, many of whom had become separated from their families. He suggested that each colony, and the city of Saratov, prepare a list of all the Polish Germans within its confines to help these people find each other again. He appears not to have been aware that Germans from Volhynia had already begun arriving in the Volga region. The Volkszeitung affirmed its willingness to help bring families together and pointed out the existence of a Bureau dedicated to caring for refugees, the “Subcommittee of the City Executive Sanitation Committee” on Cathedral Street. There is no evidence that Herr Schneider’s suggestion was ever carried out.

I have tended to preserve German spellings of place names, with a few exceptions—mainly in the case of names of provinces. Where possible, I have given alternative German names of villages in the Volga region which might not be familiar in their Russian version. I have probably not been totally consistent in the spelling of place names, for which I hope I will be forgiven. I have alphabetized the list by family names, and I have alphabetized a second list by place of origin. This will allow anyone with interest in a particular province to see at a glance all the families from that region. When working on this second list, if one runs into a “see Kludt” or other such reference, one will have to go back to the list alphabetized by family. Following the first list is an index of surnames that are not among those alphabetized in the first column, with references to the appropriate first-column surname.

For several reasons, I have not reproduced the complete contact addresses. Anyone who would like to know an exact address may contact me (currently at benovich@live.com). These addresses are given chiefly to indicate the general area in which the person was living at the time. Question marks usually indicate lack of clarity in printing, although there may be other reasons for my uncertainty, such as weakness in geography and the Russian language.
